She is also preparing for a postdoctoral project on the mystical and medical phenomenology of European female visionaries in the Middle Ages.

MARGARET FRANKLIN is an Associate Professor in the Department of Art and Art History at Wayne State University. Her current research focuses on the influence of the European epic tradition on the visual culture of late medieval and Renaissance Italy.
